William Phemister, NCTM, pianist, composer, and editor, has also enjoyed his role as professor of piano at the Wheaton College Conservatory of Music since 1972. A graduate of Juilliard (BS) and the Peabody Conservatory (MM, DMA with Leon Fleisher), and a Fulbright Grantee, he is also the winner of significant piano competitions and a performer/clinician in the United States and around the world. In recent years, he has appeared in Taiwan, Singapore, Australia, New Zealand, Mexico, North Korea, and China.

As a longtime member of MTNA, he has entered winning students in more competitions than he can count; he has also given presentations at many MTNA local chapters and at the national convention.

The topic, "Catalonian Music: Albeniz and Mompou," inspired by a recent visit to Barcelona while on sabbatical leave, provided Phemister with the opportunity to research in the beautiful Catalonian National Library. His presentation offers a snapshot into the wondrous world of Spanish music—a glimpse into literature that ought to be included in everyone's repertoire.
