The September 4th Presentation is "Handel: Beyond the Messiah" by Dr. Kyle Dzapo.

Dr. Dzapo is Professor of Music at Bradley University, principal flutist of the Peoria Symphony, and a pre-concert lecturer for the Chicago Symphony and New York Philharmonic. She has published extensively on the subject of Danish flutist, composer, and conductor Joachim Andersen, including articles for journals of the American, British, and Finnish flute societies, the book *Joachim Andersen: A Bio-Bibliography*, and a new edition of *Fünf leichtere Stücke*, op. 56, with Andersen's original publisher, Zimmermann of Frankfurt.

Dr. Dzapo has performed as a recitalist in London, Denmark, and New York and on live broadcasts for Wisconsin Public Radio and Chicago's WFMT. She has taught university courses in London and Salzburg and has been recognized with awards for both scholarship and teaching at Bradley University, including the 2007 Rothberg Award, the University's highest award for research and creative production. She earned a Doctor of Music degree from Northwestern University where she was a student and teaching assistant of Walfrid Kujala. She holds a Master of Music degree with Distinction in Performance from the New England Conservatory and a Bachelor of Music Education degree with High Distinction from the University of Michigan.

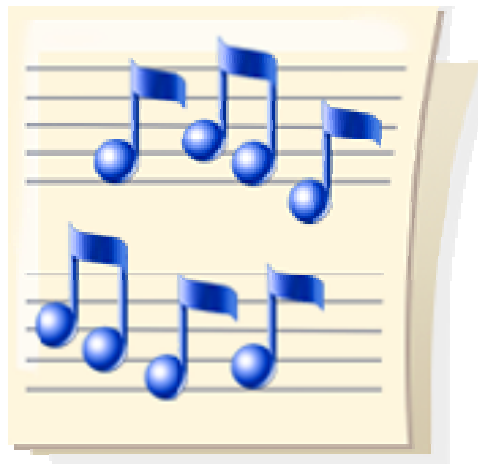
"NOTE BY NOTE" MOVIE AT SYMPHONY CENTER
